MEGEVE

Located at an altitude of 1113 m in a preserved mountain setting in the heart of the French Alps, Megève is a charming village. With its typical mountain architecture, Megève is internationally known as the place where the "fuseau" ski trousers were invented in 1930 by "Allard".

Not only is Megève well equipped for sport, offering a large choice of mountain activities, but is also home to a classical music festival and a jazz contest in the summer, which everyone can enjoy. There is even a horse show and an old car rally!

The surroundings offer marvellous walks following tracks, animal footprints, or watching clouds chasing each other across the sky..

Megève is ideal for outdoor holidays and fresh air!

THE SCHOOL

The school is situated right in the centre of the village, close to the antique shops, opposite the students' campus.

Two programs are organised at the same time: *In the land of Mont Blanc* to practice English and *Au pays du Mont Blanc* to practice French. Students are either English speakers or French speakers and gather for sports and entertaining activities. Thus, they create a good communicative context through several languages which is the originality of our formula.

English and French lessons begin in the morning with the possibility of preparing the University of Cambridge and the Alliance Française exams according to the students' levels.

To help practice the language, the students write a play, helped by teachers and staff, where everyone can do their best and have fun.

Our teachers are experienced with youngsters and their motivation guarantees the success of our program.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

Cifel organises sports and other activities using everything Megève has to offer. Afternoons are dedicated to mountain biking, summer sledding, ice skating, fishing, hiking, tree climbing and, of course in winter skiing, snowboarding, etc. Field trips to amazing places such as la Mer de Glace (the famous glacier in Chamonix Mont Blanc) or wonderful Lake Annecy will fill students with enthusiasm.

Another way of getting involved in Megève's life is to perform the play in the village square ! At the end of the day, we will all gather around a campfire or organise another event such as game contests, films, grilled trout and marshmallows... Peaceful moments allow reading, dreaming or chatting with other foreign students.

CAMP DETAILS

Jeunes Diplomates Summer camps are modeled on the American summer camps and our staff has an excellent understanding and experience with the American system. Our camp is also listed with the National Camp Association. Jeunes Diplomates staff includes our camp director, qualified French counselors (BAFA) and American counselors. The ratio of staff to children is higher than the norms set by the governing body for sports and camps in France (la Direction Départementale de la Jeunesse et des Sports (DDJS)) our accommodations, restaurant and outings are all approved by DDJS.

Ratio for DDJS: 1 counselor for 12 children

Ratio for Jeunes Diplomates: 1 counselor for 6 children

Our staff supervises the children 24 hours a day in all their activities, including their personal needs such as hygiene and/or specific medical treatment if required.

Our teachers are all native speakers. They prepare their programs around a specific theme each year. Our teaching goals are to have children progress and enrich their communication skills in an enjoyable way.

We want our courses to be alive and interesting, different from the normal school routine. The numbers of students in the language classes are limited and are determined by level to encourage the greatest amount of participation and improvement.

We want our campers to spend their summer in safety while enjoying many different activities our camps offer.



Accommodation and Meals



When your child arrives at the centre, he/she is placed in mixed groups of children of the same age. The children are allocated rooms based on age and sex. **We try** to put English speaking children with French speaking ones to maximize the learning experience.

There's a counsellor at every floor. The children are staying at Mont-Charvin hotel in the heart of the village, across from the school.

The hotel receives a visit each year from the Health and Safety inspection (Commission Hygiène et Sécurité).

Each room has 2 or 3 beds with a bathroom and a toilet and they are cleaned

every day. We offer your children top quality accommodation.



Children less than 10 years old go to bed at 9:30pm and the others at 10:00pm.

The children have their meals in the hotel restaurant. We offer a delicious and balanced menu. Special menus (vegetarian, low salt etc) can be provided if a medical certificate has been given to the camp!.

GENERAL BOOKING CONDITIONS and REGULATIONS CONCERNING CAMP OPERATION

1/ Booking

Your booking will be registered upon reception of:

- the completed enrollment form ,
- the deposit (500 €) and the booking fee (100€ or 50 €),
- the signed and completed health form
- medical certificate stating that the child is fit to practise sports
- swimming certificate

Until we have received all of the above items your child will not be enrolled

Your child will not be accepted if the balance of the fees is not paid before the camp begins.

A booking may not be changed from full board to day camp or vice versa once the child's stay has begun. This is for the well being of the group.

2/ Price and Services

The following services are included in the price:

- Accommodation for full board campers
- meals
- Counsellors services
- Sports and cultural activities
- language courses

The cost of the stay is all inclusive; there will be no reimbursement for any services that are not used.

Booking fees will not be reimbursed.

Failure to pay the balance of the fees by the deadline will automatically cause cancellation of the booking.

Payment methods:

For bookings made from November to March: payment of the balance by the 30th of April

For bookings made from April to June: Payment in full will be required.

Any failure to meet these deadlines may incur the cancellation of the booking.

3/ Cancellation

- Cancellation on your part for whatever reason:

Other than booking fees which will not be reimbursed, the following deductions will be made:

5% of the total cost of the stay if notice is given by registered letter at least 60 days prior to the planned starting date of camp.

25% of the total cost of the stay if notice is given by registered letter between 60 and 30 days prior to the planned starting date of camp.

100% of the total cost of the stay if notice is given less than 30 days prior to the planned starting date of camp.

There will be no refunds for stays which are terminated early.

Deductions made in the case of cancellation or stays terminated early are made to reimburse Jeunes Diplomates for the financial losses inevitably incurred when budgeting to ensure the best possible service for our students at a fair price.

Any quest for withdrawal, cancellation or early termination must be sent by registered letter with signed receipt.

If you wish to book your child into a different camp session, this may be done at the latest two months before the planned starting date of camp, and an administration fee of 20 euros will be charged. At any time after two months prior to the planned starting date of camp we will be obliged to enforce the cancellation terms set out above.

- Cancellation of a camp by Jeunes Diplomates: You will be immediately informed and all sums will be reimbursed to you without penalty.

Jeunes Diplomates reserves the right to cancel a camp session if less than ten children have enrolled in a camp session.

4/ Major Activities

Please do not confuse these camps with intensive language instruction.

The main activities are laid out in detail in the camp description. Please do not hesitate to ask if you would like more details. The activities described in the brochure may be modified or replaced by other activities.

5/ Insurance

6/ Loss and theft

It is not unusual in collective living arrangements that a child loses an item of clothing or other personal belongings despite the best efforts of the staff. For this reason, Jeunes Diplomates can't be held responsible, nor will we reimburse any such loss. Insurance requirements state that a police report be made in the case of theft. The loss stated above does not fall into this category.

7/ Photographs

During camp, photographs may be taken for publicity purposes or for press articles. If you do not wish your child to appear in any such photographs, please inform us in writing.

7/Expulsion

If your child fails to adapt to the camp, Jeunes Diplomates reserves the right to send your child home. You will be personally informed and all associated costs, including the cost of accompaniment, will be at your expense. No reimbursement will be made whatsoever.

9/ Arrival/ Departure

Full board:

Children must arrive on Sunday at 5:00 pm. at the hotel Mont-Charvin : 102 rue Crêt du Midi, 74120 Megève. Children will depart at 5:00 pm. on Saturday.

Day camp:

Children must join the camp on Sunday at 5.00 pm at the hotel Mont-Charvin 102 rue Crêt du Midi..

Each morning campers should be at 8.45 am at the hotel Mont Charvin. Parents will pick them up at 7.00 pm each evening at the same place.

At both arrival and departure, it is necessary for an adult to accompany the child. If this adult is not the parent or legal guardian you must supply Jeunes Diplomates with written confirmation of the name and address of the person who will accompany your child.

For any other departure by your child from the camp you must supply Jeunes Diplomates with written confirmation describing the means of transportation and with the name and address of the person who will accompany your child. Your child will not be permitted to depart without an accompanying adult.

We will give you our cell phone number to contact us in case of emergency.

If for whatever reason your child must leave the camp early, the departure will take place on the following morning after breakfast with the parent or legal guardian.

10/ Medical Care

During the camps, Jeunes Diplomates will advance fees for the following: visits to the doctor, and/or medicine.

At the end of each camp session, parents must reimburse any medical expenses. In the case of illness, doctor's visit, or accident, you will be contacted by the camp director as soon as possible.

No medicine whatsoever may be taken during the stay without the accompanying prescription.
